
More FiDi Construction Sites Get Makeovers; DOB Wary of Earl

FIDI—The Alliance for Downtown New York's mission to make Lower Manhattan construction eyesores less ugly, officially dubbed the Re:Construction public art program, continues with three new pieces by New York City artist Richard Pasquarelli. The first, "Restore the View," was just unveiled on the Fiterman Hall site at 30 West Broadway. The other two works are "Secret Gardens," to be installed at the Chambers Street road construction project, and "Hours of the Day," at the new W Hotel's "piazza."
